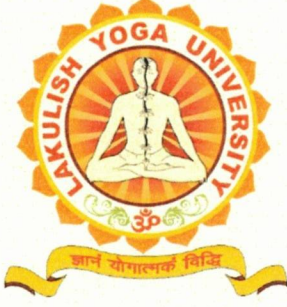


# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

### PREAMBLE

Lakulish Yoga University (LYU), Gujarat, is India’s first University exclusively dedicated to Yoga education, and dissemination, with a strong emphasis on Indian Knowledge Systems, spirituality, and holistic health sciences. The University endeavours to integrate traditional wisdom with contemporary academic frameworks and promotes excellence in teaching, research, extension activities, and community engagement.

The International Naturopathy Organisation (INO), functioning under the Surya Foundation, is a nationally and internationally recognized organization committed to the promotion, development, and implementation of Naturopathy as a preventive

and cost-effective healthcare system. Since its formal establishment in 2003, INO has been actively engaged at grassroots, national, and global levels, upholding the principle that *“Prevention is Better Than Cure.”*

Recognizing their shared vision and complementary strengths in the domains of Yoga, Naturopathy, preventive healthcare, and holistic wellbeing, both Parties hereby agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to foster academic, and outreach collaboration.

### **ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE OF THE MoU**

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a collaborative framework between Lakulish Yoga University and the International Naturopathy Organisation for joint initiatives in education, training, outreach, and capacity building in the fields of Yoga, Naturopathy, preventive healthcare, Indian Knowledge Systems, and holistic wellbeing.

### **ARTICLE 2: SCOPE OF COLLABORATION**

The areas of collaboration under this MoU may include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Joint organization of workshops, seminars, conferences, symposiums, webinars, and academic events.
2. Development and delivery of short-term courses, certification programs, and training modules in Yoga, Naturopathy, and preventive healthcare.
3. Faculty, expert, and resource-person exchange for lectures, mentoring, curriculum enrichment, and professional capacity building.
4. Student exposure through internships, fieldwork, health camps, community outreach programs, and grassroots initiatives.

### **ARTICLE 3: TERM AND TERMINATION**

This MoU shall come into force from the date of its signing and shall remain valid for a period of **three (3) years**, unless terminated earlier. Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing **thirty (30) days’ written notice** to the other Party. In such an event, all ongoing activities shall be allowed to conclude in a

manner that does not adversely affect students, faculty members, or other stakeholders.

#### **ARTICLE 4: NON-BINDING NATURE**

This MoU is non-binding in nature and does not create any legal, financial, or contractual obligations between the Parties. All activities undertaken pursuant to this MoU shall be based on mutual consent, academic cooperation, and institutional goodwill.

#### **ARTICLE 5: FINANCIAL TERMS**

This MoU does not involve any financial commitments by either Party. Any activity that entails financial implications shall be governed by a separate written agreement duly approved by the competent authorities of both Parties.

#### **ARTICLE 6: SINGLE POINT OF CONTACT (SPOC)**

Each Party shall designate a Single Point of Contact (SPOC) to facilitate coordination, communication, and effective implementation of activities undertaken under this MoU.

#### **ARTICLE 7: RESPONSIBILITIES OF INTERNATIONAL NATUROPATHY ORGANISATION (INO)**

The International Naturopathy Organisation shall:

1. Provide subject-matter experts, practitioners, and resource persons for academic, training, and outreach activities related to Naturopathy, Yoga, and preventive healthcare.
2. Collaborate with LYU in organizing national and international conferences, health camps, awareness programs, and training initiatives.
3. Facilitate student and faculty exposure to community-based and grassroots-level health initiatives.
4. Support policy advocacy, and promotion of preventive healthcare systems.

### **ARTICLE 8: RESPONSIBILITIES OF LAKULISH YOGA UNIVERSITY (LYU)**

Lakulish Yoga University shall:

1. Collaborate with INO in academic, extension, and outreach activities aligned with Yoga and holistic health sciences.
2. Facilitate participation of its students and faculty members in joint programs, training modules.
3. Provide academic infrastructure and institutional support, as mutually agreed, for collaborative events and programs.

### **ARTICLE 9: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS**

Any intellectual property generated through joint activities under this MoU shall be governed by mutual consent and in accordance with applicable institutional policies and prevailing laws of India.

### **ARTICLE 10: CONFIDENTIALITY**

Both Parties agree to maintain confidentiality of any proprietary, confidential, or sensitive information shared during the course of collaboration under this MoU, unless disclosure is required by law or mutually agreed upon in writing.

### **ARTICLE 11: FORCE MAJEURE**

Neither Party shall be held responsible for failure or delay in the performance of its obligations under this MoU due to events beyond reasonable control, including but not limited to natural disasters, acts of God, pandemics, government regulations, or any other force majeure events.

### **ARTICLE 12: AMENDMENTS**

This MoU may be amended or modified only by a written instrument signed by the authorized representatives of both Parties.


